A colourful parade of sails filled the harbour with classic yachts, heritage vessels, and modern cruisers.

- 30 Boats on display, from high-tech Navy vessel to wooden masterpieces
- Oldest boat on display was *Colonist* from 1880
- Newest boat was an electric boat from local maker *Naut*.
- Over 300 people enjoyed steamboat rides .
- 106 visitors on Spindrift
- The stunning 1928 topsail schooner Windborne drew big crowds with public tours and storytelling onboard.


